

How to stop Google training on your email

Google has started training its Al models on *your* email and other content. In the EU, this is opt-in, meaning it's not on by default. However, in the US and other countries, you must manually opt out to prevent them from doing this. It's not hard, but definitely not obvious how to do this!

Lauch Gmail and click on the Gear to see Settings




Select See All Settings




Select manage Workspace smart feature settings

Toggle off (UNcheck) both "smart features" and Save

Back in Settings, uncheck Smart features.
